Summer Research Update



This summer, the department has five student scholars in the UW School of Medicine & Public Health's Shapiro Summer Research Program. The program consists of 8-10 weeks of mentored research conducted by student awardees between M1 and M2 years. The students working on research with Urology faculty this summer include:

Taylor Penn: Taylor is working with Dr. Richards exploring the impact of Agent Orange exposure on bladder cancer outcomes.

Katharine (Kat) Tippins: Kat is investigating the role of percutaneous biopsy in patients with large renal masses with Dr. Abel. Kat is also the student leader of the Urology Interest Group.

Alyssa McClelland: Under the mentorship of Drs. Abel and Lubner, Alyssa is studying the clinical outcomes associated with radiomic analysis in renal angiomyolipoma.

Arun Augustine: Arun is working on a project with Dr. Jarrard, looking at whether 5a-reductase alters MRI.

Eduardo Miranda Mora: Under the mentorship of Dr. Grimes, Ed's research pertains to quantifying collagen content in human lichen sclerosus.
